Our study about Kingdom Math showed that there is stability for God's people even in the midst of economical instability in the world (Psalms 33.19, 35.10, 37.18-19, 65.9-13, Isaiah 32.18, 58.11, Habakkuk 3.17-19)

We learned that God multiplies: obedient sacrifices, all that we have, small things that may seem insignificant

We learned that things that hinder multiplication are: wrong (non biblical) beliefs, unintentional idolatry, self-pity, feeling of inadequacy, excuses for not investing in the Kingdom

We learned that things that foster multiplication are: truth, loving and obedient sacrifice, courage for faithful risk taking attitude

We learned that some outcomes of multiplication are: freedom, release of God's transforming power, healing of brokenness in all areas of life, awakening to see reality from the Biblical point of view, transformation: personal and in all areas of life.
