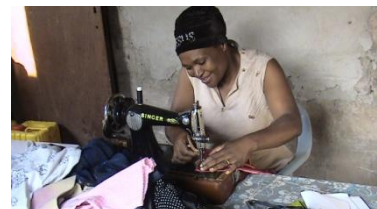


A two days vision casting organized by Pastor Jean Nsoseme of the Intra-community Parish of Ma champagne and animated by Buingo, Byamungu and sister Aurélie Mbala, was in the goal of reinforcing the applications of the conference vision held in 2009 and also in the follow-up of the ongoing seeds Projects in action within this church, in that area. In addition, it was an opportunity of sharing experiences on the management of the seeds actions' growth. Pastor Jean is one of our actives trainers in the town of Kinshasa.

In fact, a group of women on the supervision of Mrs. Nicole Nsoseme had initiated some acts of service in order to help the girls to stand on their own feet through the manufacture of perfumes, disinfectants for households and sanitary facilities, bleach, and it is a small training class of about 15 women and 3 men.



In addition to that, there is another class of 11 young people who learn the dress making. This class is under-equipped; they have very few machines that a woman had offered to the group as a sign of “action seed”. There is still here need of more sewing machines for better helping these girls to follow their training in good condition.



This casting allowed the trainees to acquire more knowledge on the mandate that God gave us, that to procreate by our creativeness, the love for God and for neighbor in need, the model that Jesus gave us on maturity and the service in order to help of others to move towards God's intentions for them, the small acts of service which they can often do to serve the world around them in all the spheres of the man's life and at all the levels.

After this training, the participants have been encouraged and have took new steps to continue their training and business, putting into practice the love which is a significant element to mark the presence of the church in the city.
