

Reparation of ten (10) houses in Bainet

Introduction

The earthquake of January 12, 2010 had an impact more devastating than the news or the words of the media. Three of the ten departments are affected by the quake. Many houses are destroyed or severely cracked. Many people died.



The community of Bainet in Southeast Department has not been spared from this terrible disaster. It is in the same condition as Jacmel and Port-Au-Prince. Contrary to these localities, the country's authorities and NGOs are not really the audacity to support the rescue of this community really an isolated area, this is a miserable area. No health care, no good school, any structure to give assistance to the population.

Bainet is a community in the South-East department, whose chief town Jacmel, the distance of thirty two (32) kilometers. It has ten (10) community sections, included the city center, and divided into twenty four (24) large and ten (10) small habitations.

96% of houses are made of rock, masonry and mud-covered with straw. The earthquake of January 12 reversed almost all the houses and damaged some others. It is within this context that REKOT (Harvest-Haiti), with the relief money from our donors, make decision to help those isolated people to repair some houses, now 10 houses are already repair in the residential of Lafeyade (Lower Grandou, 5th section Bainet), which has permanently relocated a total of ten (10) families, sixty seven (67) persons.

- 1.Small survey to recruit beneficiaries
- 2.Evaluation of houses before the reparation
- 3.Photographer houses to repair
- 4.Mobilization of beneficiaries and the community to participate in activities by providing sand, rocks, water etc.
- 5.purchase cement and plate
- 6.Recruitment and payments for workers compensation

Results



Families before the repairing of houses were sleeping under trees or in the street after the earthquake, and even before the reparation of their houses. Some of them gave their children as "restavek" or with other family members or other people away who were not direct victims.

Now, ten houses have been repaired, which allows these people to have a new housing, residential fixed sleep with their families.

Now, they can take back their children home from the "RESTAVEK"

Reaction of beneficiaries

After completion of the activities of home repair, we had a day's work with beneficiaries of these homes and their families, 67 people in total share their emotions in this meeting, we took their photos and stories we indicate below:

Here, we provide reactions of some beneficiaries.

1. Enita Janvier, 39 years old and 5 children

After the quake, my house was destroyed. All the walls were crushed and became inaccessible to introduce myself with children. I was in despair and dismay. I felt really sad and abandoned. I was sleeping under a coconut tree with my children, tempers in the rain and exposed to cold and heat of the day. In my despair, I could not see where to go and what to do. I could not sleep in the street and I had no home.



But today, God rescued me, through Rekot and all those who contributed. My house is quite serviceable and I could again sleep at the shelter from the cold with the children.

I have no words to thank God who laid eyes on me and my children. Thank you to you all and God bless you and your family.

2. Exael Dieuva, 48 years old and 9 children

After the earthquake, I was sleeping under a orange trees with my husband and my children. The animals slept with us and snakes too. I spent more than six months in this way, until God makes me relive the hope by giving up my house where I now sleep with my children. I now have an address and protect from rain.



I start with words of thanks and gratitude to you who have reached the pure working. My house is now standing. Thank you very much to you, because of your donations, we can sleep in our own home.

Without you, my children and I still be under trees. May God bless you greatly?

3. Feliane Duperat, 65 years old and 2 children, husband died

Since the earthquake, I had no place to go. To sleep, early, I sat with a neighbor, but the house has no top space to accommodate a variety of people, which forced me to sleep around my house in a house that I made up in coconut with straws etc.. Unfortunately, during my slumber, a whale that was lit set fire to my tent straw was burned, but God saved me.



When I looked at this house that is now fixed, I can not hold back my tears that spill from time to time by my contentment.

I thank Pastor Guérino and all members of Rekot who contributes to repair my house and many others. I pray for you every day, asking God to protect you and hollow joy in your work. May God protect your home, your children and your family. Thank you very much.
