A group of 25 believers, among them doctors, nursing students and members of the Evangelical Church in the city of Chincha, south of Lima, came together to offer 2 days of free medical attention, with their own resources, to a group of 357 inhabitants of Chincha. They got the necessary resources: medicines, anesthesia, fluorine, toothpaste, toothbrushes, antiparasite pills, gloves, cotton, needles, syringes, forceps tickets for prescriptions, water, pens, record cards, notebooks, etc.

The dentist was not a believer; he was a friend of the pastor. It surprised him to see everyone working without expecting anything in return, only for the love of the Lord with the desire to help those in need with the little that they could offer.

The people who benefited from the medical campaign, were very grateful to God for the help they received. The community's response to this service was immediate and through it they were able to have some of their medical needs filled. The people who collaborated who weren't part of the church, upon seeing the resulting unity and expressed love, have also started to believe and to attend the church.
