### **Openness to the biblical wholistic message within Karagwe local church**

Dominic is an Evangelist from the Nazarene Church of Rwanda. He attended the Vision Conference and his first Training of trainers event in August 2005 in Kigali. From that date, he understood that the message on Wholistic Ministry was so important to the Church of Christ and volunteered to work with Harvest team in Rwanda.

While committed to serve with Harvest team, he still goes for Evangelism trips. In his trips of Evangelism in Tanzania and Burundi, he uses the Harvest and Darrow's materials as preaching subjects.

In October 2009, Dominic spent three days preaching on "Church as a Window" in Karagwe. After the three days, Pastor Charles Karugendo of the Karagwe Full Gospel Bible Fellowship Church in Tanzania realized for his first time that they had narrowed the biblical message to just the spiritual message. He committed to make of his church a wholistic type of Church and added the following: *"Now my eyes are open to what God intends the Church to be doing. It's really the window that God uses to demonstrate His Intentions and to show His manifold wisdom."* He extended his invitation to Dominic to visit them every year.

In addition to what Pastor Charles expressed on the wholistic message, some members of the Church from the attendance (the attendance was about 500 people) came to Dominic and expressed their gratefulness for the message and added that the Church in Tanzania needed that message for the healing of their nation.
