

Covenant Church Seed Project

Cleaning, teaching, and having fun in
the Slum

- Covenant Church has been doing seed projects for the last year in their community where there are slums, mainly working with the children. They have been doing bi-monthly projects. This time they teamed with a girls' school (Satree Non), which is located in the Nontaburi Province north of Bangkok, to do a seed project in the slum area of the community. (In the pictures, the girls from the school are dressed in their green school uniforms. All of the girls from the school are Buddhists.)

- When Covenant Church realized the girls from the school were required to do a community service, the Church invited them to do a joint project. Together they worked with the children from the slum area to clean their neighborhood. After doing their cleanup project, the church team taught English to both the schoolgirls and the community's children by telling them the Christmas story in English and teaching English vocabulary based on the story. Finally they played a game and sang songs.
