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The idea came since I worked for FH. The material I developed in order to help the church to develop a vision for the community included a few parts: 1) After discussing the lessons on the Broken Relationships, the church would do a community survey investigating peoples perception about the key problems in the community. 2) After this exercise, the church would discuss the results and start thinking about God's intentions for the community doing a drawing of what they would like to see in 5 or ten years in the community. We called that "A church's vision for the community". 3) A following session would include the lesson on God's intentions for the church and the present. The Chalmer center uses a short version of God's intentions for the community as a way to develop a "Vision for the community". On the training (picture below), every group was presenting their group vision of God's intention for the community.
