and sensitization against the HIV/AIDS. For the moment, we have 23 orphans in the city of Kinshasa, by assuring their education (school fees and stationery), medical care (a guaranty of 15 \$ by child for health insurance during 3 months extendable), nutrition and a program of micro-project.

We officially began this program on July 22, 2009 at 17th CECU/MASINA parish, on this occasion; we proceeded to the distribution of the school kits and school uniforms.

Being a "distant adoption", the food is ensured by respective families of reception; certain children pose problems of daily nutrition and hope that the program can also intervene in this but for the moment our budget is still limited. In term of the difficulties, there are some of our children who lack even decent clothing and sometimes we are also unable to reach the orphans living in the peripheral districts because of means of transport.

Teaching/Training:

1. Vision Conference

Next week Buingo plans to go to Lubumbashi for five days Vision Conference and he will take this opportunity to do a follow up of seed projects carried out during previous Visions Conferences. Please pray for him and for this trip. Lubumbashi is around 2000 miles far from Kinshasa by airplane.

2. Vision Casting

From 16 to 17th October, Buingo was in Boma (in Western Congo about 585 km from Kinshasa city) where he conducted a vision conference for 12 leaders and elders from Calvary church. This opened doors to a series of vision conference next year.

On Monday, 9th November Pastor Martin facilitated a "Vision Casting" session to four leaders from "Christian Service of Micro Enterprises, (CSME). In return they asked to organize a Vision Conference for all their staff. Pasteur Kongolo, the SCME leader also requested a Vision Conference for members of his church in the next days.



3. Discipline of Love

In November 1997, Nancy Ufeti and her son Jephté Minga 3 years old arrived at the church - Missionnaires' Actions for Nations Evangelisation (MANE) after having been abandoned by her husband and their family. They are now taken in charge by the church for their socio-economic integration. For the moment, Nancy learns dress making at a training centre supported by the church. Nancy and her son depend on the church's support where Romain Diaku is the senior pastor, a member of Samaritan Strategy Congo.

4. Seed Project - "Tithe Gift Project"

- On Tuesday, 10th November Buingo and Martin Mambula carried out a Seed project to the profit of four poor women in granting to each of them a rotary loan (marr - go-round) of US 50\$ for starting small business. Next week the group of recipients will increase to eight members.



5. Developing a Team

We will also have a mentoring with 22 trainers on 28 November. Please pray for our time with them and for the commitment of each of us.

Publications and Translations

Since we started the translation last year in November, we have already finished two books and are now working on a third one, which is "Local Church ministry Training". We hope by the grace of God to complete it in March 2010. We still need prayer and

financial support for brethren who continue to volunteer for this work.
