1. **Angola:** In collaboration with Rev. Philip chairman of "Fire for the Nations International", we plan to organize a vision conference in Luanda. The event will consist in helping as an entrée point into Portuguese countries of Africa. Please join us in prayer for guide and help of the Holy Spirit during planning of this Vision Conference.
2. **Kinshasa:** On 29th August 2011, Martin and Jean N'soseme led a Vision casting for about 76 pastors members of Kinshasa Pastors council. This meeting materializes the collaboration between Samaritan Strategy-Harvest and National Council of Church of Christ in Congo. At the end of that casting, two Vision Conferences have been planned for "Communauté des Eglises de Kwango" and "Communauté des Eglise de Pentecôte de l'Afrique Centrale". We still need your prayer and support for the success of these conferences.
3. **Kwilu Ngongo:** After a casting hold last month in Kwilu Ngongo, Brother Alphonse KANKU (Eglise Cité Bethel) said: "Through this casting of Harvest ministries, we have discovered that is possible to change the image of our communities, if we commit ourselves to put into practice the wholism message. This seed sowed through casting helps us to understand our place in our families and nation".

He added: "God has given to us the necessary for our development, but why *are we poor and hungry?* I think this is a call to stand up on our own feet for fighting the poverty of mind and other social illness. Poverty is a culture, let's be the pioneers for leaving out of that culture for others to follow our example".

#### 4. **Central Africa Republic-Bangui:**

When we were at Lausanne Congress in Cap Town 2010, we met Rev. SINGA-GBAZIA Nicolas Aimé Simplicie, chairman of "Association des Eglises Baptistes Evangéliques en Centrafrique", with him we plan to organize a Vision Conference and Training of Trainers in Bangui City. From there we hope to train a team that will help to reach other countries in central Africa region (Gabon, Cameroun...)

#### 5. **Idiofa Bible College:**

In our efforts of seeing the wholism message reaching students at Bible colleges, we plan to organize a vision conference in November this year at Idiofa Bible College. This is like a piloting test with idea to extend to the Anglican youth college in Boga town. Our pray is to reach the point where by the Wholistic Ministry can be incorporated into Bible college's curriculum.
