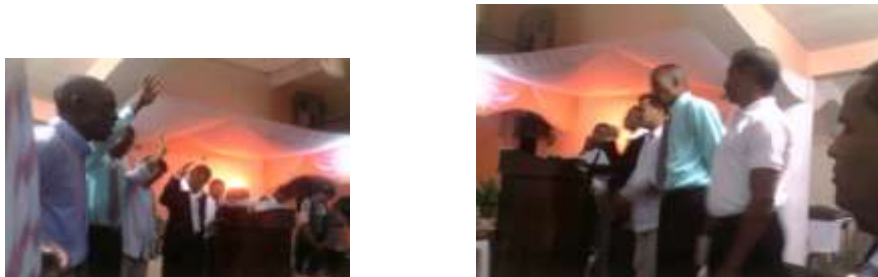




we were invited to participate at a Conference by Ricci Paulino to know more about the leadership. My wife, my girl and the Confraternity President were with me.
