Vision Conferences.

Our first Vision Conference in Niamey, Niger with pastors and Church leaders ended successfully with 62 participants. Samaritan Strategy team for Niger has been put together. Our team leader in Togo Rev. Happy Aziadekey of Togo did excellent facilitation. We had the opportunity of having our transformation message to be taught on the national television network for more than an hour!!

Partnerships & Other Training Programs & Meetings.

1. The Humanitarian International Services Group (HISG)

Our partnership with HISG has been most outstanding. I facilitated a Worldview and Wholistic Development conference in Addis Ababa hosted by the Great Commission Ministry (Campus Crusade Ministry of Ethiopia) and the Humanitarian International Services Group (HISG). Working as a team with HISG and the Dynamic Business Start-up Project of South Africa. 62 participants mainly from the Great Commission Movement staff of Ethiopia with over 85 percent of the participants being ladies well trained in the area of spiritual evangelism and discipleship, Jesus film and others. However, it is the first time many of them are being exposed to worldviews and wholistic ministry

2. CHE West Africa Transformational Conference.

The West Africa Transformational Development Conference hosted by CHE was well attended about 150 participants. It is just beautiful to see like minded organizations like Global Reach, CHE and DNA/Samaritan Strategy teaching and working together.

3. Adult Bible Class

Two days was spent mentoring our third training team-they teach our materials in the various 3 local languages in Ghana. For five years, this group of 8 persons have been using our BASIC 1 & 2 to teach in the Pokuase branch of the Church of Pentecost adult bible class which has resulted in the transformation of individual lives and church growth. Another group of 9 have been trained for the Holy Ghost Deliverance Ministry (HODEM).

4. AFRICA WORKING GROUP

Our first annual meeting of the Africa Working Group came off in Kinshasa, Congo DR which was very successful. We focused on the Lord's call on our lives and our humble mission of building teams of transformation across Africa.

5. Ghana Pentecostal Council

We did a presentation at the Ghana Pentecostal Council (GPC) Church leaders conference. Their theme for year is "Impacting the nation through Transformed leadership". Our presentation of the wholistic transformational message to the 200+ membership was just appropriate and they promised to work closely with in the coming years.

Students' Campus Ministry

My lectures at both Pentecost and Maranatha University Colleges ended successfully. Students of Maranatha business school showed their deep appreciation and a chapter of the wholistic club to fully internalize the teachings has started

opportunities in the country. The trainees started their money making activities with 2,300 birr and by the end of the training the total money they received from selling their products were 50,300 birr with gross profit of 18,300 birr. Is that not amazing! My wife has exported 70 Injera to Equatorial Guinea yesterday. Her bread is going very well. In the training she was the leader of making money.
