Training of pastors and other leaders including church leaders has been our main focus. Thank God that He is giving us all that it takes and the grace to continue in this Kingdom business.

### **1. Pastors and Church Leaders Conference in Accra East.**

Our offices are located in this part of Accra which is quite rural yet one can find hundreds of churches. Many of our training programs in Ghana had concentrated in the regional capitals. Most pastors in this rural communities are untrained and rely absolutely on the gifts of the Holy Spirit to ran their churches and yet have large congregations. This program targeted this rural pastors and church leaders. In all 35 leaders attended and they were overwhelmed with the depth and wholistic message. Various seed projects have been planned and a follow-up meeting is scheduled in September .

### **2. Harvest, HISG PARTNERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM IN ARARAT, ARMENIA**

At the invitation of the Humanitarian International Service Group (HISG) in cooperation with 222 Ministries, I was privileged to be the main facilitator of the week in this great country of Armenia. Issues of worldview and wholistic ministry was adequately discussed. Even though, this was my first experience of teaching in East Europe, I was lovely received . My experience in Armenia demonstrated the beauty of the Kingdom of God, where there is no black or white, old or young, male or female but in Christ we are one!! To God be the glory.
