We had a vision casting from 21st to 23 July 2010 in Ahepe, a village about 70 km from Lome. The conference took place in Shalom Temple of Evangelical Mission, and gathered 131 participants from 10 different denominations. Some participants come from surrounding villages of Ahepe. Wholistic materials taught was done in the Ewe, the local language of the area. The conference was facilitated by Kossivi Ativi, one of those I am mentoring and myself (Happy Aziadekey). At the end of the conference, 20th August was chosen for the follow up meetings.

All participants were very happy about the program and glorified God because they could understand the topics in their own language, and according to them they have never heard these teachings.
