TRAINING FOR STUDENTS OF WAAST (West Africa Advanced School of Theology) IN LOME

The great opportunity God gave us in the month was the training at WASST. Students were ending their third year training of **Bachelor of Theology** and were graduated 6th November 2010. They were 90 students from 11 countries of West and Central Africa, 25 for English class and 65 for French class. English class students were from Cameroon, Ghana and Nigeria. The most numerous were Ghanaians who were 20/25. French class students were from Benin, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Congo, Ivory Coast, Gabon, D.R.C., Thad, and Togo.
