Teaching/Training; 1. Within the month of February, I travelled to Cape Coast with Patience and met with some of our third generation of trainers trained by Rev. Joshua Lamptey. Fifty trainers have been trained but forty-seven (47) of them were present at our meeting to tell their stories. These are leaders at the grass root level, very low income and needy people who have accepted the wholistic gospel and going about doing good and demonstrating the love of God to their neighbors. A lady told of her desperate situation, staying at home and doing nothing. One of the participant who was one of the early one's trained by Rev. Joshua, gave her \$50 as seed capital. This has multiplied and now she can take care of her children school fees and her home.

2. Together with Rev. Asante and Kofi of the Baptist University College, we continue to put our materials into three Christian Universities-Pentecost, Maranatha and Baptist University Colleges both in their Theology and Business Schools with over 600 students being exposed to our materials and teaching

Publications: We did not do any significant publication work.

Network: We attended a three day special delegates conference of the Ghana Pentecostal and Charismatic Council. This is the biggest federation of Churches in Ghana of over 300 denominations and thousands of churches. We were accepted as a member and already, we have planned for four regional Transformation Conferences in Koforidua in the Eastern Region, Accra in Greater Accra, Cape Coast in the Central Region and Tamale in the Northern Region.

2. We also participated in the African Working Group meeting of the Samaritan Strategy, Africa and the global meeting of the DNA which was a good learning process for me, good networking and fellowship.

Administration: Minor administrative activities was done, getting our social security right, tax payments done and various bills paid

Goals: We continue to work towards increasing our Community Leaders Training Programs at the grassroots, empowering more of our Generational Leaders, and working for more V C's in Ghana and other West African countries. Finally with our partnership with the Ghana Pentecostal Council have four regional Transformational Conferences.
