Teaching/Training:

1. We had a Vision Casting event with the Adabraka area of the Apostolic Church of Ghana and the New Achimota Worship Centre of the Church of Pentecost with 80 and 50 pastors and church leaders participating respectively. It was very refreshing to see how these leaders deeply appreciated the teachings on Luke 2:52 and Development. Many of these leaders comparing their lives and growth to that of Christ now realized the urgency for them to arise and shine to reflect Christ in every domain of life.
2. The first Wholistic Community Leaders Training of the year also came off very well in the month with 10 community leaders carefully selected from Accra, Kumasi, Cape Coast, Suhum and Ho attending. According to them, this type of training is very urgent if we are to disciple the nations. They have drawn up many seed projects and discipline of love to implement in their various communities. Within a period of three months, they are to train five others for them also to start living a life of obedience and also multiplication.
3. In collaboration with Compassion International, we had a day’s training program at Aburi in the Eastern region of Ghana. 101 participants, made up of pastors, church leaders and other community leaders attended. These were leaders from both the Akwapim North and South districts of the region. For many, it is their first experience with the wholistic ministry and they were so thankful to God and Compassion for the training.
4. Our radio program “Transformation Time” on the national radio is still making huge impact on Ghanaian listeners. Last month, our discussions on radio was Seed Projects and it is wonderful, the inputs we had from the public.

Publications: We continue to work with the materials we already have.

Network: As part of our collaborative work with the Ghana Pentecostal and Charismatic Council (The biggest Church federation in Ghana with over 230 churches and over 10 million members.), we have started working towards the first pastors and church leader’s conference in Accra in June. Please do pray with us.

In partnership with Mercy Ships three pastors and church leaders conferences have been planned for Sierra Leone. Currently, I am in Freetown in the second week of the first two of the conferences in Bo and Freetown respectively. Please continue to pray for us.

Administration: I continue to work closely with Pastor Happy Aziadekey, Harvest associate staff of Togo, my two staff members-Patience and Stella and my team members across Ghana and West Africa.

Goals: Our goal is to continue to expand the wholistic transformational vision and mission in Ghana and West Africa. This we continue to do through the duplication process of the Wholistic community leaders training program, Training of Trainers and Mentoring programs. For this year, we hope to do Vision Conferences in Guinea Conakry and Guinea Bissau to complete our first phase of putting the wholistic Transformational message vision in all West African countries.

Seed Project Story– Pokuase near Accra.

One of the Wholistic Clubs in Pokuase near Accra is headed by Madam Emma, There was an isolated piece of land which was weedy and filthy and yet close to a church premises. The club knowing very well that if Jesus were Mayor he would have turn things right and they being Ambassadors of Christ in their community cleared the place, cleaned it and has turn the place into a safe place for kids in the area to meet for their soccer games.
