



Monthly Report – April 2011

Youth's training. We continued wholistic development training with the youth of Amadahome and Kodome on the topic: **"Jesus, our model of Growth and Service"**. Concerning the four areas of Jesus' growth, we were focusing the wisdom, what is it. In order to help those youth to increase their knowledge by reading, we organize for them a conference on reading. In the coming days we shall be working on the topic **'The importance of reading'** –why to read, the advantages of reading, how to read a Book, a Magazine and a Graphic- will be the main points of the presentation. The guest speaker is a Christian, a professor at University of Lomé. Some local churches in Lomé are invited to this conference.

Children Development's Workers Training. We had a special training for two local churches who are involved in Children Holistic Development Program. These two churches: MESA Church of Kodome and Pentecost Church of Sanguéra have **"Children Development Centers"** This initiative is a fruit of partnership of Compassion International with these churches. In order to help the workers who are leading

this program, one day training was organized for them. We led them through the base of wholistic development, or the four areas of growth (wisdom, spiritual, physical and social) their manuals talk about. At the end of training, the participants were all satisfied because according to their testimony, they understood now the focus of wholistic development and they can also have a good use of their manuals which talk about holistic development.

Bible study facilitators training. We continued the training for facilitators of bible study groups of MESA Church. They were trained to facilitate bible study in French and Ewe classes. After three months study about **"The Irreducible Minimum"** in **Local Church Ministry Training Manual**, facilitators started a new bible study lesson: **"The Image of God"** in **BASICS II** with church members. We still have three French speaking groups and three Ewe speaking groups.
