



## Monthly Report – May 2011

By the grace of God, we ended the fifth month of the year 2011. Though my dad's funerals preparation for around the end of May concerned me, we were able to focus our normal activities as planned for that month.

**Youth's training and conference.** The wholistic development training for youth of Amadahome and Kodome went on May. We still worked on "**Jesus, our model of Growth and Service**". In order to help those youth to increase their knowledge through bible and books reading, we had 14<sup>th</sup> May the conference about reading as provided for. They were asked to invite their fellow to the conference. They were 132 youth (without children) from seven different local churches to attend the conference. The main points of the topics were: **the importance of reading or reading, a duty; and how to read**. The guest speaker was Professor Christophe DIKENU, a Titular Professor of University of Lomé, Togo. Verily, he communicated to his audience the liking of reading. At the end of the conference, participants were full of satisfaction. We noticed also the presence of some adults at the conference. One adult told me at the end that they also need such a conference because they spent times at home without doing anything, while they could read. We also evaluated the conference with youth of Kodome. Many testimonies were given and many decisions were also taken for reading.

**Bible study facilitators training.** We had training with bible study group facilitators of MESA Church. We had two training sessions with them. The first session had duration of 1hour and half, the second session had duration of three hours. These facilitators continued to lead their groups of bible study every Friday evening from 6: 45 to 7:45 pm. These facilitators still continued the lesson on **“The Image of God” in BASICS II** with MESA church members.

**Bible study supervision.** We supervised three times bible study in groups at MESA Church. They still have three French speaking groups and three Ewe speaking groups. The topic is still **“The Image of God” in BASICS II**.

**Village missionaries' training.** We spent our four hours of training with village missionaries in two sessions, still on Wholistic Development. For the first session, we ended **why to work, how to work and how to use his salaries.** For the second session, we taught “**Reviving the Reformation**” as an application of these topics.
