**FOUR MAN VISITATION TEAM TO AKURE**

A four man team left Lagos on the 29<sup>th</sup> of July 2011 for follow up meeting in Akure, (Pst Ishaya Amos, Esther Amos, Gogbo Wakama and Paul Davo).

The team had a meeting with 25 people, mostly pastors and church leaders of various denominations drawn from different parts of Akure. The meeting took place at the resource centre of Chrisma impact (Rev Leke) on the 30<sup>th</sup> of July.

Pastor Ishaya Amos spoke briefly on the following topics as a reminder for the conference messages.

- The meaning of Samaritan Strategy/Harvest
- The power of story. Our stories! How they are based on our cultural world views. He also explained the different types of world views.
- ABCs of culture and the four windows.

After the teachings there was time for questions and answers. A call was made for those who would like to commit their time, energy and resources to further the wholistic vision in Akure. 19 people indicated their interest to run with the vision. A further brief session was held with them to explain more closely the assignment. The conclusion was that a vision conference should be done in Akure this year or early next year. We therefore asked them to choose a date agreeable by all and communicate to us. Their response is still being awaited.

The vision of the Samaritan Strategy/Harvest was shared with the proprietress of Living Legacy school, and she was very much interested about the package. She promised to organise a training session for her staff. A date is yet to be fixed for that.
