Monthly Report – September 2011

Though I was sick during the month of September, the grace of God was upon us and His Spirit still led us and worked with us. I thanked God for those I trained, and who were on the field the hole month while I was stable under medical treatment. In September, our activities went as below:

Children and Kids' Coaches training. In collaboration with Explosive Evangelism (EE), we did three days training for children and kids' coaches in Tomefa, a nearer village to Nyamessiva. We realized during Nyamessiva youth camp that there were many children in the area. Most of them use to come to church Sundays, but their instructors were spiritually poor. We felt the need to help them. That is the reason why we conceived this special training program in collaboration with (EE). The training gathered 45 children from 9 to 16 year old and 8 Church kids' coaches. The objective of this training program is that, those children who will be trained can train their younger brothers and sisters.

We also trained 14 adults for evangelism by the same EE organization. At the end of the program, we gave bibles in French and Ewe (local language speaking in the area) to 26 needy, youth and adults who are not able to buy it.

Participants' impression: All the participants are satisfied. According to them, they are now equipped for the great Commission toward children, youth and adults. They gave glory to God and promised to do their best in the task God given to them.

Youth's Training. The main activities of youth of Amadahomé and Kodome in the month of September consisted to learn to make envelop. We also did youth camp evaluation and planed follow-up of August evangelism. Two youth were sent twice for follow-up especially in two villages.

Village Missionaries' Training. We did our normal monthly training program with missionaries who use to go weekends for evangelism, follow-up and training in villages.

Discipleship Training. The discipleship program of Noepe went as usual during September. The two sessions of every weekend were well respected by the participants. They always express their joy and satisfaction at the end of every session. Also, they use to do with passion practical lesson exercise trainers gave to them.
