



Monthly Report – October 2011

For you yourselves know how you ought to follow us, for we were not disorderly among you; nor did we eat anyone's bread free of charge, but worked with labor and toil night and day, that we might not be a burden to any of you, not because we do not have authority, but to make ourselves an example of how you should follow us (2 Thes. 3: 7-9).

The mighty hand of our God was with us in the month of October. We did many activities as:

Youth's training. Our common wholistic training program with youth of Amadahome and Kodome went well in this month. We are planning some activities which will help them to grow intellectually and wisdom.

Missionary's training. We did as usual, wholistic training for missionaries who use to go in villages for mission. A part from their monthly two training sessions, some went to Have, Nyamessiva, and Tomefa for children and kids' coaches who were trained in September follow-up. They also gave school supplying to needy pupils. Those who went to Agove and Atitoe did the same gift to needy pupils in those areas. These gifts allow them to go to school this year. In Nyamessiva, the school Director personally comes to us with his collaborators to express his gratitude, because of the needy pupils' gifts. The wholistic program we are applying in villages brings more understanding into people mind and our missionaries are always well accepted in the villages.

Discipleship Training. Discipleship training program of Noepe every Saturday morning and Sunday afternoon continue normally during all the month. These are some testimonies from the Pastor of the Church, Pastor GOKPE Jean: "16 members were registered for the discipleship training, but 10 used to attend the teaching, 6 were regular. The attitude of these disciples is changed, in their behavior you can notice the confidence in God and their prayer life are changed. Also the started to win souls for Christ and advice people in trouble and pray with them".

I also had the opportunity to teach in Disciples Training School of Youth With A Mission at Agou, a village located on a mountain and distant of 110 km from Lome. I spent five full days training with 20 students from Benin, Congo, Ivory Coast, France and Togo. The Topic related

to God, His nature and His attributes. It was a wonderful moment full with revelations and transformation according to students' testimonies.

The opening of Nyamessiva Dispensary. By the grace of God, we finished to plant Nyamessiva Dispensary. Last 21st October, we did it inauguration in presence of the village chef, its notables and some villagers. Now the dispensary is serving population of this area. The Dispensary is constituted by a consultation room and an hospitalization room with two beds for patients.
