We have more of one week under strong rain, the families of the communities don't have food besides being affected by breathing issues, stomach illnesses, and illnesses in the skin; many families have lost all their belongings, their crops, their houses, also that the communication roads have been damaged and many communities are isolated. We was working with more than 300 families, almost 1,500 person, 11 communities, 11 churches and we are hope to God provide for their needs, thanks to God we have 29 excellent organized and qualified voluntary leaders, located in each one of these communities who are working helping in their communities, please keep praying for all of them.

Thanks God our leaders moved faster to help the others in each communities while the government was trying to coordinate the help, the necessary actions was already taken by our leaders. Was amazing the love between the communities of; El Coyol, La Pena, El Limon, El Araujo, La Joyada, Los Llanitos, Piedra de Agua, El Porton, Marcovia, La Barranquilla y El Paraiso. Glory to God! ## October/Alex Fearon

In Honduras, the most rainy season is October, is when there are floods all over the country, crops fail and people have to be removed from their homes by the danger of floods in the capital Tegucigalpa Honduras is also vulnerable to rain, that affect us through the local church could mobilize one of the poorest neighborhoods of the capital where, after several visits we were able to detect that 27 families lost everything in the home rainwater exceeded the roofs of houses and as a result were sleeping on the street in the neighbors' houses. Our work began with some motivational talks, that made the brothers of our local church to collect clothing; shoes and more emergency food for 27 families in total were 100 people, adults and children. After making the stock move the family could place a sibling group of volunteers who came in contact with each of these families to pray and to share the love of God. As a result of this activity many families accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior.



## November/Alex Fearon YWAM Base Costa Rica.

Thank God we had the opportunity with my wife Loyda be able to YWAM base in the city of San Jose Costa Rica where we could teach the Curriculum Harvest with a group of students from around the world, Canada, Island of Samoa, Panama, Mexico, United States, Germany, Costa Rica. In our week of training could take the students to visit the church of a pastor friend I met in Honduras, called Alberto Castro who have a church in a small town in Costa Rica Call Alajuelita, with this pastor have shared the vision of Integral ministry for a long time and as a result of this vision, we visited the various projects that the Church has:



The first day we went to visit the Center for Rehabilitation of Alcoholics and drug addicts for the Men of the community, we pray and we were able to share the Gospel with them and hearing his testimonies and then we visited the school and the church has 35 students from the community with full scholarships to them were, uniforms, shoes, clothing, food and studies. The vision is professional Christian citizens returning to the community. We were also able to visit the nursing home that has the Church are people who are homeless and that this place serves as a home.



On our second day trip to get to meet the community rehabilitation center for women who have come out of drug addiction and prostitution, was a good opportunity to hear the testimony of each of them of how God through the church could be rescued from Alcohol and drogadicts.



Our visit to the Church ended with a visit to the community nutrition center where the church feeds 120 children from the community, sing and teach them the word of God they give music lessons and musical instruments to eventually integrate into the Church. Also these children join the sports center of the church where they have a sports school for children of the community, is a center that serves all age groups but specially for sports tournaments, which in turn paid these economic resources are used to sustaining community programs of the Church.



Some lessons learned during this visit to Costa Rica were.

- 1) Local development if it is possible in the community as long as the pastor be in holistic Vision.
- 2) With few resources development can be done.
- 3) Community development will be 100% effective when the pastor lives in a community as the best example is that of Alberto Castro who lives in the community.
- 4) Students could see that the curriculum is not only theory but also practical action to demonstrate God's love to the Community.
