D. New contracts with workers-masons



During the first operation to rebuild ten (10) houses in Bainet, we established an association of workers-masons mobilized and sensitized to this effect. These are people caught in the middle of the community intervention project and who used to work in the community.

They took the decision after meetings of awareness, lend their support to victims who sleep under trees or other and work with a reduced salary.

Each worker should contribute and occurred in all sites to the success of each house.

E. Community mobilization



Before we begin the process of repair of houses, we conducted a community meeting in order to warn the community project, recipients and present them to empower the various activities to promote institutional input.

At the end of this outreach event, the population had consented to lend their support in providing materials that are on their doorstep, such as: rock, sand, water etc. and support workers Masons Throughout the course of the project.



At the end of the repair of all eleven (11) homes selected, another meeting was conducted with residents of the community, including churches and community leaders, members of the population.

This meeting was designed to assess each house repaired and consolidate overall impact of the indirect beneficiaries' community.

I thank you with all my heart, because thanks to you my children are asleep and warm.

2. Ms. Paul Bourgoïn, 58 (Chilli Nan, Lafeyade)



It's really hard for seven (7) months after the earthquake; I was still asleep in the street or under the coconut trees. I have six
