At the end of this outreach event, the population had consented to lend their support in providing materials that are on their doorstep, such as: rock, sand, water etc. and support workers Masons Throughout the course of the project.

At the end of the repair of all thirty one (31) homes selected, another meeting was conducted with residents of the community, including churches and community leaders, members of the population.

This meeting was designed to assess each house repaired and consolidate overall impact of the indirect beneficiaries' community.

F. Consolidation of some reactions of the beneficiaries themselves



1. Mr Anold Cénat, 80 (Earth-red Lafeyade)

The past, when I saw the repair of houses of my neighbors, I was happy to

finally see the interior of a house to sleep, even if for me, I was still sleeping under trees. Today, God has laid his eyes on my pain and my troubles in remembers me from those who helped me was my house repaired. I thank you with all my heart, because thanks to you my children are asleep and warm.



2. Ms. Paul Bourgoïn, 58 (Chilli Nan, Lafeyade)



It's really hard for seven (7) months after the earthquake; I was still asleep in the street or under the coconut trees. I have six (6) children and my husband, we all slept under the stars. I have no

words to express my joy at seeing today my house rebuilt. Thank you very much and God bless you for everything you did.



3. Islande Joachin, 65 ans (K-Ferton, Lafeyade)

I was not selected by the committee



during the first ten (10) houses repaired and that, frankly, was difficult to conceive. I like them, sleeping under trees, but I understand now that God had reserved for this period. Nothing was left of my house, everything had collapsed, but today it is fully repaired. I am sleeping inside with my kids and my wife. We are really happy, because God delivered me.

4. Ygebien Lundor, 61 ans (La Feyade)



At my age, I was not expecting to rebuild a house destroyed in the earthquake was 10 seconds, but God helped me with this project funded by people



who do not know me. Thank you very much and God will protect you

5. Leyone Vilsaint, 45 ans (La Feyade)



I slept in the street and under trees after the earthquake, I had lost all hope, the earthquake has carried me all I had,



but God helped me. Thank you very much to all who have contributed to the reconstruction of my house.

G. Conclusion



It is true that we are already talking of success and perfect results. But the project, at its



implementation and its realization is not without difficulties and huge risks. However, this project

which is still running, incurs a significant impact in this common intervention. We have testimonies, visual impacts. It is thirty-one (31) houses repaired in several months of activities that have already impacted almost positive. These are activities that are beneficial in the



sense of a real improvement in living conditions for targeted community which is the reintegration and resettlement of affected families, the true victims of the earthquake. The side of the field investigation team, this project is a reality beyond words.
