Ministry among the poor people and especially in the villages in India is a blessing. I count it as a blessing because these people are very much eager to hear about God, especially when you present the Gospel through different mediums/modes.

In the month of August, apart from my regular ministry of teaching to pastors and church leaders, I was able to organize a special ministry for the slum people, villagers and school children.



A Korean Taekwondo team visited Bangalore in August. Their mission was to present Gospel through Taekwondo skills demonstrations. I arrange a program in a small village church. Due to lack of space, we shifted outside the church where the team-members taught songs to children. They sang songs that talk about God's love and our response to His love through opening the door of our heart. They even invited few children to break the plywood plates while shouting "Jesus, I love you!"



Next day I arranged the Taekwondo demonstrations for school children in another village. This special school is run by a medical doctor, who is a longtime friend from my childhood. He has started a ministry in the villages. I connect with him for medical ministry among the slum and poor people. The Taekwondo team taught action songs and distributed balloons and candies. Most of these children are Hindus and Muslims.



It was wonderful to see many people from the neighborhood come and listen songs and the Gospel. Most of them saw this kind of demonstrations with songs for the first time in their village. God blessed all and everyone was happy.

Then I arranged another program in the slum area where I go for ministry among the nomads. Again the Koreans were the attraction for people, especially for children. They taught actions songs, shared Gospel through Taekwondo demonstrations.



Some of the team members shared their testimonies. After their demonstrations, they asked few children to break the plywood while shouting “Jesus, I love you!”



At the end, we had a special prayer meeting for the children. The team-members were so moved by compassion over the children that they prayed for the children and interceded on their behalf.
