He has running three schools for poor and needy one especially for *Kamaiyas* who were bond slave until 2001. Those schools were started as seed projects initially. Recently he had drinking water projects in three communities. He came to Christ 5 years ago in the Philippines through Bishnu. He is interested to join and serve the Lord with Harvest.
