



My Legs Are No More Twisted

My name is Rita Nepali. I am from the family which is considered untouchable according to Hindu religion. I lost my parents while I was still young. I was raised by my grand mother. Being a poor, disabled, I was having hard time going to school. One day, I went to a medical camp organized by Tansen Church where I met Ps Bishnu who helped me to go to Tansen for additional treatment consulting with Dr. Indra and Mr. Baral. As I was there in Tansen, Ps Bishnu helped me bring to hospital and allowed me to stay at his place. I was amazed seeing a Brahmin allowing me, untouchable, to stay at his place and care for me. It is uncommon practice in Nepali culture. I was so impressed that I was attracted to go to a Christian fellowship following week. Mr. Baral and Bishnu helped me going to Katmandu for further treatment. I had 6 operations in six month period and eventually my twisted legs were straight. In this course, number of people and organization helped me. As I understood the love of Christ, I accepted Him as my Lord and Savior and got baptized a year ago. Before, I used to be worried thinking that nobody would marry me. Now I am not worried about my future because I have a new hope, new family who always cares for me. I praise the Lord for giving me a new life. My friends Laxmi and Junu also came to Christ as they saw my changed life. One of elders in our village said in the community meeting last month "Jesus has been so good to Rita." As a response I said "Jesus is not only so good to me, He is also so good to you and everyone in the village."

Seed Project in Prison



In last visit, Lily and Puspa came to know that Danny has some problems with his hands. He has been imprisoned in Tansen jail for quite sometime for a murder case. They helped him had a surgery by consulting to a mission hospital. Now more people are opened to the gospel in the prison because of that little help. Eventually, he came to know Christ and got baptized last month in the prison. Lily and Puspa are praying for a sewing training especially for women prisoners as the next seed project.

Highlight of the Month

Four years ago, Indra Baral was only Christian in the village. He was prosecuted and not allowed to have fellowship even at his own house. But it did not stop him for sharing the gospel with others. However, no one believed in the gospel until he came to understand that we are to demonstrate God's love through the act of service. As he started doing so, people are attracted to the gospel and believed in Jesus. After four years, there are twenty baptized Christians and around thirty regular attendees to the fellowship which was eventually declared a church this week named - New Hope, giving hope to the community. Indra Baral is the one of them who has been practicing biblical wholism in his personal life and ministries.
