After the movie and a short message, a group of 35 people prayed and gave their lives to Christ.

We don't mean to say that we've done something really great for her; we feel that what we can do for our Lord is very little. But we have been the ones who have been most benefited because it filled our hearts with joy, with love and with great satisfaction. We feel that that she has blessed us in a very special way.

These pastors have taken semester courses in Biblical Worldview and Holistic Ministry.

Pray that the new graduates will apply what they have learned in their local churches. Each year we train an average of 70 students.
- Pray for the "Manhood" and "Unique Women" Courses that are given at the Christian Church of Holistic Development.
- Pray that the Lord would give us the wisdom, time, energy and resources needed to train and mobilize strategic leaders to holistically disciple our nation in our generation.
