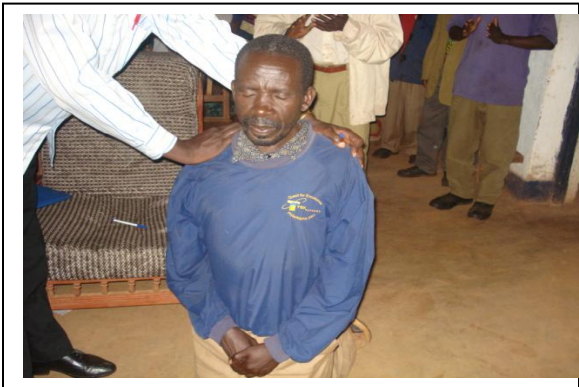

## **Kibimba/Burundi Vision Conference**

*The Lord abhors dishonest scales but accurate weights are his delight. Proverbs 11:1*  
In Burundi from October 3 through 6, we worked with Elim Charismatic Pentecostal Church of Burundi whose Bishop Simeon Nzishura had by coincidence met Bob in the USA and by that chance had time to talk with him about wholistic training. Back in Africa, bishop Simeon contacted Simon for the training. It took much time for the training to be held, the venue changed but it happened at the right time in Kibimba, the central part of the country.

Kibimba/Gitega in Burundi is known by many because of the 1993 massacre of Tutsi that happened in Burundi. We couldn't believe it was a safe place for us to go and hold a 4-day training. But we believed in God's protection and went. It's a remote place but it was very wonderful for us during the conference for three reasons. (1) Kibimba was the first place we have met **a big group of Batwa** (pygmies) in our trainings (Batwa are a non-reached people up today). (2) **We have experienced a training using music** because Pygmies love music and are good singers. (3) In Kibimba we also experienced and enjoyed **a very amazing experience of repentance** with Bosco, one of the Conference participants. Let me tell you about Bosco as he allowed us to give testimony to many for the Glory of God.

Mr Bosco Barayavuga is 56 years old. He has accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior in 1989 after a long period of working under satanic spirits. Now, he works as deacon in Gitega local church. He has never been in school, he doesn't read or write. But he knows how to turn a scale to increase or decrease the measures according to the request of the owner. After he was saved, he used to work with businessmen during the harvest seasons when peasants sell their harvest and when they buy. But after the lesson on the Kingdom of God, he repented about the mess of fraud and asked us to pray for him. He was released from the satanic chain of fraud but he also witnessed of his miraculous healing from a chronic disease. The Kingdom of God which was our motto during the vision conference came in his spiritual, physical and emotional life. **He declared that the Vision conference was held for God's purpose for him.**

During the vision conference in Kibimba, it wasn't only training but a discovery. We did discover how good it's to train rural people because they are not so used with training events like people in towns of Rwanda, Burundi and DR Congo. People in Burundi gave so many testimonies on how they were so blessed by the training. We had to stop the number of people giving testimonies because the number was big.

### **Goma/DRC Vision Casting**



40 people attended the training in Goma from November 24 through 26. We expected to cover the Vision Conference materials but because the schedule wasn't respected, we just considered a Vision Casting conference. The 40 people were representing the Club of Pastors, a new association of pastors recently initiated by Bishop Joshua Lwango of Victory Church. The association aims at strengthening the relationships among pastors and builds a strong body of Christ. It will bring pastors together into fellowship and eliminates the competition of churches in DR Congo.

**Kigali Vision Casting** A one day Vision casting was held for more than 120 people during a Convention organized by the Christ Gospel Fellowship Church in Kigali. With the Vision Casting Conference, we came up with an appointment to meet with the Pastor Francis and see how to organize a Vision Conference in 2010 for the Church leaders.
