TRAINING PROGRAM

27 pastors and leaders planned their work on the development starting with me in the four areas of personal development Luke 2: 52. We have this requirement for purposes of graduation of the first level of the curriculum of training.

35 new leaders of different denominations began the level I of the curriculum of training and eight new churches began to use Basic (discipleship for new believer).

We had two casting of vision for new churches interested in learning about the education program where we simultaneously gave 95 brochures to pastors and leaders interested in learning more about us.
