

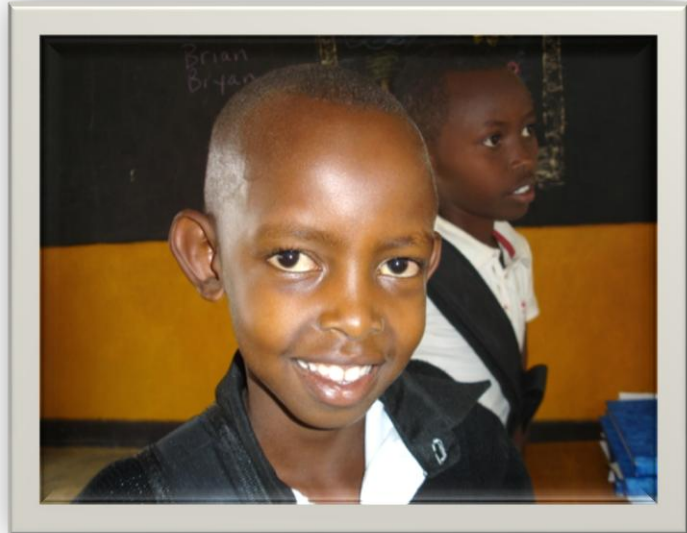


Emmanuel (God with us) We met

Emmanuel in 2008 during our first visit to Rwanda with Think Compassion. He was four years old and attending pre-school at Good Shepherd Community Church. We were touched by his story, and Ray Tollison, of Think Compassion, took this fantastic picture of him during class. Emmanuel's father passed away (from

HIV/Aids) when Emmanuel was one. Emmanuel and his mother are also HIV positive and both are taking the government-provided medicines that help their immune systems cope with this destructive and deadly disease, that unfortunately has impacted so many lives here in Rwanda, and elsewhere.

Today Emmanuel is enrolled at our school, Good Shepherd Primary School. He is currently in 2nd grade and is doing well, both scholastically and physically. Health wise, he is benefiting from the school's porridge program and the vitamins that our school provides him, and the other



children. **Think Compassion**, and other generous contributors, have paid for these programs that allow the children to benefit from nutritional help. We thank God for Emmanuel and for many other precious children like him that we are in contact with every day at our school. We currently have 315 students enrolled at school and approximately 130 are sponsored by **Think Compassion** sponsors!
