God is blessing the fact that these pastors are learning to be friends and to work together! Now, on Dic 10, they are planning to have a united picnic day, at a park, for the families of these churches to be together, play and have a great fellowship time. **Renacer Church** – Beginning this month (Nov 1-5), we celebrated our national convention at my large church Renacer. The theme was: "Transforming our Nation" and God spoke to us about the fact that Biblical transformation is the result of God's work, not our human work. Also, He reminded us that: a) Transformation begins within us: I need to be transformed in order to be an instrument for transformation in God's hand. b) We need to work with the family (inside the church and also outside), restoring and rebuilding the family according to the biblical principles. c) We need to train the new generation (Children, teenagers and young people), to apply Kingdom of God's principles to every area of their life and society, so they can become like: Joseph, Joshua, Nehemiah, Daniel, etc. Around 150 pastors and leaders for other churches attended the event and for everyone it was a special time of confrontation and impartation concerning the role of the church in society and our call to manifest the Kingdom of God on earth as it is in heaven. I believe God is starting to wake up His church in Venezuela about the urgency to work with the children and teenagers, and He is giving us the right theological frame, strategies and tools to do the work. Glory to God for that!
